Master Officer Kenneth Bloomfield retires after 25 years with the Fort Pierce Police Department

FORT PIERCE – After more than two and a half decades of protecting and serving the citizens of Fort Pierce, Master Officer Kenneth Bloomfield will retire May 19, 2007.

Bloomfield was honored on Monday, May 7, 2007, at the City Commission meeting for his many years of service.

He began his career on October 29, 1981 and since that time was deeply devoted and committed to his responsibilities as a law enforcement officer. During his career, Bloomfield served in several different special assignments including as a detective in the Investigative Services Bureau, a member of the department's traffic unit and as a Field Training Officer. Currently, Bloomfield is assigned to the Patrol Unit in Neighborhood Policing District One.

Bloomfield has been involved in several special operations that had a tremendous impact on crime in the city. In September 1988, Taylor working with his platoon, made 182 felony arrests, 242 misdemeanor arrests, 11 D.U.I arrests; wrote 48 parking tickets, 13 warning citations, 691 traffic citations and seized 33 vehicles, a large amount of cash, drugs and narcotics.

Bloomfield has, throughout his career, received numerous commendation letters and accolades from citizens and various law enforcement agencies for his hard work, dedication and outstanding service. In addition he received several department awards including a Meritorious Police Duty Medal in 1998 for his heroic actions and performance during a life threatening situation at Lawnwood Regional Medical Center. He has been an invaluable part of this department and mentored many new officers.
