FORT PIERCE – At approximately 11 a.m. officers responded to 20th Street and Avenue G in reference to a call involving a fight. Upon arrival, the officers determined that sisters Tametrise and Shanelle Dixon attacked Angelica Hudson who was trying to carry infant Monica Powell into the residence located at 714 N. 20th Street. During the attack, infant Powell fell to the ground. The sisters continued to batter Hudson while infant Powell lay on the ground. A witness, who called 911, picked the baby up off the ground. The attack was a continuation of an altercation that occurred at a store located on 23rd Street. Hudson escaped the first attack, leaving the baby's mother and best friend Cherry Ross behind at the store. Hudson drove to 714 N. 20th Street, her sister's residence and the scene of the second attack.

Infant Powell was airlifted to St. Mary's Hospital in West Palm Beach. She has been treated and will be released.

Angelica Hudson was transported to Lawnwood Regional Medical Center where she was treated and released

Tametrise Dixon was arrested and transported to the St. Lucie County Jail.

Shanelle Dixon was transported to Lawnwood Regional Medical center as a precaution because she is 7-months pregnant. Upon her release, Shanelle Dixon will also be arrested.
