Armed robbery suspect identity sought

FORT PIERCE – Detectives hope the release of surveillance footage will lead to the identity of the suspect wanted in the armed robbery of a local pharmacy.

The suspect is described as a white male, 23-24 years of age, approximately 6'0" ft., 170 lbs, clean shaven with a low haircut. He was last seen wearing a light blue shirt, blue jeans, and a blue hat.

Police believe the suspect may be connected to similar incidents in Port St. Lucie and Indian River County.

Background: On 07/21/2008 at approximately 10:45 am, an armed robbery occurred at Oceanside Pharmacy, 1118 Colonnades Drive. The suspect approached the counter and asked the victim if she had any Oxycodone. The victim responded yes and the suspect lifted up his shirt and showed a brown wooden handle handgun and demanded the Oxycodone. The victim led the suspect to the area where the pharmacists were working. The suspect showed the gun to the two pharmacists they handed the suspect five bottles of generic brand Oxycodone.

The suspect fled the scene in a 2000 white 4-door Nissan X-Terra with no rims.
