Attempted armed robbery suspect identity sought

FORT PIERCE – Detectives hope the release of surveillance footage will lead to the identity of the suspect wanted in the attempted armed robbery of a local pharmacy. The suspect is described as a white male approximately 6'00" 150 to 170 pounds approximately 40 to 50 years of age with dark colored hair and a mustache. The suspect was wearing a striped blue polo shirt, light faded blue jeans, a dark hat and black work boots.

On 9/11/2008 at approximately 9:31 p.m. an attempted robbery with a weapon occurred at the CVS Store located at 2220 S US Highway 1. The suspect jumped over the pharmacy counter and attempted to steal Oxycodone. He approached an employee and brandished what appeared to be a kitchen knife.
