Police canines aid in arrests of suspects in separate crimes

FORT PIERCE – In less than a week police canines played a key role in the apprehension of two suspects.

On November 3, Sylvester Eleby, 17, of Fort Pierce was arrested after police service dog Rex, handled by Officer Christopher Guadagno, found Eleby in a vacant lot.

Eleby, who was bitten on his right chest and shoulder area, was transported to Lawnwood Regional Medical Center where he received medical clearance before being transported to the Juvenile Detention Center.

He was charged with burglary of an unoccupied dwelling and resisting arrest without violence.

Five days ago on Friday, October 30, Officer Robert Stagner and police service dog Bingo assisted the St. Lucie County Sheriff's Office with the arrest of a suspect, who robbed a business with a firearm.

Officer Stagner and Bingo tracked Russell Matthews, 29, of Fort Pierce, to the 5000 Block of Lace Avenue. Matthews was arrested after Officer Stagner noticed he was trying to leave the residence, located at 5014 Lace Avenue.

Officer Stagner released Bingo to apprehend Matthews after Matthews refused several requests from the officer to get on the ground. Bingo ripped Matthews' pants while pulling him to the ground.

Matthews was turned over to St. Lucie Sheriff's Office deputies when they arrived. Matthews was charged with robbery with a firearm (SLSO Case #1-08-013792).

Narrative

On 11/03/2008, at approximately 2127 hours, officers were dispatched to 609 North 20th Street, Fort Pierce, St. Lucie, Florida, in reference to shooting activity coming from 609 North 20th street.

Upon arrival, as I approached 609 North 20th street, I heard loud banging noises coming from Apartment B. I walked to the front door of the duplex from an angle and as I was approximately three feet from the front door of apartment B, I observed the front door open slightly and a black male wearing blue jean shorts and black t-shirt, attempted to exit the door. When the male, later identified as Sylvester Eleby, observed my presence, he quickly slammed the door and re-entered the residence. However, when the male slammed the door, the door did not close and remained slightly ajar.

A few seconds later, I heard a fence rattling in the back yard. I relocated to the rear of the apartment and observed a similar featured male wearing the same clothing (blue jean shorts and a black t-shirt) jumping over a fence fleeing the scene west towards North 21st Street.

Officers set up a perimeter in the area and K-9 Officer Guadagno(4925/536) with his police service dog Rex canvassed the area for the subject. The subject was located in a vacant lot just north of the residence at 610 North 21st Street. Police service dog Rex did come in contact with the subject and the subject was bitten on his right chest and shoulder area.

I made contact with Eleby, who was wearing blue jean shorts and a black t-shirt. Eleby spontaneously uttered that he entered the apartment with two other unknown black males and then ran from the apartment and hid in a vacant lot until the dog found him. Eleby also uttered that he does not know the owner(s) of the residence.

Eleby was arrested for burglary to an unoccupied residence and resisting without violence. He was handcuffed which were checked for tightness and double locked. Eleby was transported to the Lawnwood Medical Center for medical clearance. I contacted Kenneth and Wilhelmenia Eleby at phone number 772-489-2670, and informed them that their son was in custody at Lawnwood Medical Center, and being transported to the Juvenile Detention Center, after medical treatment. Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth and Eleby acknowledged and stated they would take care of it.

After Eleby received medical clearance , he was transported to the Juvenile Detention Center. Photographs were taken.

Officers on scene attempted to locate the residence/owner of 609 North 20th street, but were unsuccessful. A check of the Saint Lucie County Property Appraiser web site revealed that Linda Braynen was the owner of the property. Ms. Braynen could not be located for a statement. Officers secured the apartment prior to leaving.

Narrative

I responded to the 7-11/ Mobile store at 399 E Midway Rd to assist the St. Lucie County Sheriff's Department to investigate an armed robbery to the store.

When I arrived I was given the description of a black male wearing a gray and red jacket and dark jeans. I deployed K9 Bingo at the front of the store and ordered him to track. Bingo started tracking south along the storefront then turned east. He continued tracking east until he reached the back of the store then he turned south. The track turned east again through a yard. As we were tracking I saw some people sitting on a well-lit porch in the rear of a home. I asked them if they saw someone run by the yard. They said no but it sounded like someone got a car stuck in front of the house. I continued the track coming out onto Lace Ave. in the 5000 block. I saw a black SUV with a black male driver, Russell Mathews, with a gray jacket on in the yard at 5014 Lace Ave. The SUV was stuck and Mathews was trying to get the vehicle out of the yard. I drew my handgun and pointed at Mathews and ordered him out of the vehicle. He exited the SUV and stood in the door with it open. I ordered him to the ground a number of times. Mathews looked around took a step away from the vehicle. I told him that if he did not go to the ground that I would send the dog. K9 Bingo was barking and pulling towards Mathews. Mathews still did not go to the ground and looked like he was about to try and run. Observing this, I allowed K9 Bingo to get closer to Mathews. I ordered Mathews to the ground again and he took another step towards Bingo. At this time I allowed Bingo to apprehend Mathews. Bingo grabbed Mathew's pants and pulled him to the ground. Mathews through his hands up and I called Bingo off. Bingo stood over Mathews barking at him. I told Mathews that if he moved Bingo would bite him. Mathews complied with my orders this time and stayed on the ground until the Deputies arrived and placed him in custody.

The victim was brought to the scene on Lace Ave and identified Mathews as the person that robbed him.

Mathews did not receive any injuries from K9 Bingo. Bingo just tore the right side of Mathews pants.

Deputies found a handgun on the passenger seat of the vehicle. The gun was loaded and cocked with the hammer back. Mathews had money and cigars on his person. The items were identified as the items that had been taken in the robbery.
