Detectives continue to gather information in city's 4th homicide

FORT PIERCE – Police detectives are still trying to determine the circumstances that left a Fort Pierce man dead in a vacant lot Thursday morning.

At about 6:30 a.m. officers responded to the intersection of North 20th Street and Avenue E and found Cleveland Stevens, 29, of 1908 Avenue O, in a vacant lot southwest of the intersection. He was pronounced dead on scene.

Stevens, who was shot multiple times, was lying on his back near a tree.

Since the murder, the Investigative Services Bureau detectives have been canvassing the neighborhood, following up leads and gathering evidence to piece together the events leading up to the crime.

This is the city's fourth homicide this year.
