Police Chief announces substation expanded hours of operation

FORT PIERCE – Expanding the police substation hours during the summer offers greater access to residents seeking to take advantage of services traditionally unavailable to them after 5 p.m.

Beginning Sunday, May 18, 2008, the lobby of the Willie B. Ellis substation will be open until midnight seven days a week and holidays to respond to the needs of our residents. The substation, located at 1220 Avenue D, will be manned by members of the Community Service Aides Unit.

Many of the services offered during the normal hours of operation, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, will be available to anyone needing assistance. For example, property owners can request “no trespass” signs, residents and visitors to our city will be able to file a police report either by phone or in person, schedule meetings, file an officer complaint or commendation, or register a bicycle.

City Commissioners will reevaluate the pilot project at the end of a 16-week trial period to determine its fate.
