Last suspect sought in botched home invasion arrested

FORT PIERCE – The U.S. Marshal's Fugitive Task arrested the last suspect sought in a home invasion that left one of three suspects dead from the encounter.



Shannon Holloman, 23, of 2602 Avenue M in Fort Pierce, was arrested on Thursday, February 5, 2009, without incident. Holloman, who has eluded police for the past three months, was transported to the St. Lucie County Jail. He is being charged with second degree murder and armed robbery.

At about 8:30 p.m. Thursday, November 6, 2008, victim and homeowner Glenn Hedrick was approached by three black males in his home located at 1222 Raymond Avenue. During the confrontation, Hedrick and the three males exchanged gunfire. Isaac Collins, 31, of Fort Pierce was shot and killed while Gregory Evans and Holloman fled the scene.

Less than 24 hours after the crime occurred, detectives arrested Gregory Anthony Evans, 31, of Fort Pierce. Evans was charged with armed robbery and second degree felony murder.

Because the deceased suspect was killed during the commission of a felony, Florida State Statute states that Evans and the Holloman can be charged with 2nd Degree Felony Murder.

Hedrick was also arrested on November 6, 2008 for possession of a firearm by a convicted felon in connection with the home invasion.

Narrative

On 11/06/08, at approximately 2035 hrs, Fort Pierce Police Officers responded to the area of Raymond Avenue in reference to shooting activity.

The information was called in by and anonymous party refusing to provide his name. The call was traced to the area of 2911 Okeechobee Rd.

While in the area of Raymond Avenue (1100 Block) searching for a possible crime scene, Ofc Pate received a flag down in reference to a home owner that shot and killed a burglar in his residence located at 1222 Raymond Avenue.

Upon arrival a tall w/m exited the residence with his hands above his head. He was ordered to a sitting position approximately 50 feet from the front door of his residence.

The victim, Glen Hendrick, informed officers that three armed black male suspects wearing all black clothing, including gloves and masks, entered his residence and attempted to rob him. We observed a b/m (suspect) lying on his back in the doorway to the residence. The suspect was motionless and appeared to have a very weak pulse. The suspect was approximately 30 years old, wearing a black long sleeve shirt, black shorts, black gloves, and a black ski-mask. The suspect was later identified as Isaac "poochie" Collins.

Rescue immediately began treatment on the suspect until he was transported to Lawnwood Regional Medical Center where he was pronounced deceased at 2145 hrs by Dr Soto. The deceased suspect was positively identified as Isaac Collins by a family member.

The victim, Glenn Hendrick, was also transported to Lawnwood Regional Medical Center for a possible gunshot wound, but was later medically cleared.

Detective Cuti then responded to Lawnwood E.R. in reference to a black male inquiring about a male that got shot. Cuti then responded to Lawnwood E.R. and met with Vincent Green. Vincent stated that he heard that his brother was shot. I then asked him how he knew that someone was shot. Vincent stated that he heard from some boys around 25th St and Ave Q but could not give me any names. I advised Vincent that I could not advise him of who was shot due to just arriving at the hospital.

Detective Cuti then met with Johnny Green at Lawnwood E.R. Johnny stated that he was at Publix when he looked at his phone and observed that he had a missed call from Isaac's cell phone. Johnny then called Isaac's phone and a male that goes by Greg (Unknown Last name) answered the phone. Johnny stated that Greg stated Isaac was shot come to J-Rocks house and I tell you what went down. Johnny then picked up Vincent at his house and they drove to the area of 25th St and Ave Q by the One stop Shop to meet with Greg.

Johnny then stated that when they pulled up to the house (Unknown Exact Location) and met with Greg and Shannon (AKA Spark). They told both Johnny and Vincent that it was a robbery that went bad. Johnny advised me that after the shooting that Spark called from a pay phone to report the shooting. Johnny advised me that Spark told him this. Johnny then stated that he heard Greg state that they were trying to get money and weed from a house when the cracker got Isaac. Johnny stated that Spark was bleeding from what he thinks was his right hand. Johnny stated that Spark was shot during the shooting. Johnny advised me that he observed Sharon's car were they met with Greg off of 25th St. Detective Cuti then advised Johnny that he needed to met with his brother Vincent. Johnny told me that his father was outside the E.R. and he would get Vincent. Detective Cuti then met with Johnny Green Sr and he advised me that he was going to pick up Vincent and bring him back to the hospital so can met with him.

Detective Cuti then met with Vincent Green about thirty minutes later at the hospital. He stated that he got a call from his brother Johnny stating that Isaac was shot and he was going to get picked up. Johnny then went to Vincent's house they both drove do the area of 25th St and Ave Q. Vincent advised me that when he got out of the car he saw Greg and Spark. The both of them stated they it was a robbery gone bad and a cracker got Isaac. Vincent stated that he saw Spark bleeding from the hand. When Detective Cuti asked Vincent about the robbery he stated that he knew as soon as he heard that Isaac got shot he knew that it was a robbery that went bad. Detective Cuti then asked Vincent how he knew this. He stated that Isaac told him on Sunday that he was going to land some money this week by robbing someone. Isaac did not inform him of who or were the robbery was going to occur.

Detective Cuti was informed by Det. Charlie Davis that he knew J-Rock to be Jerry Alfred who loves at 1609 N 24th St. Det. Jones and Det. Cuti responded to 1609 N 24th st and met with J-Rocks girlfriend. She stated that J-Rock was at Indian River State College. She then called J-Rock and advied him that we were looking for him. J-Rock called Det. Jones on the phone and we met with him at Big Apple Pizza located at South 35th St and Virginia Ave. J-rock stated that he was home with his girlfriend all night when Greg Davis came to his house around midnight and told him that Isaac was shot. J-Rock stated that Greg never told him how he found out. J-Rock stated that nobody else came to his house last night. Greg was at his house for about ten minutes. The location of J-Rocks house matches the location that was given to us by both Johnny and Vincent Green.

Detective Jones was able to determine that Greg was in fact Greg Anthony Evans. Detective Jones contacted Greg Evans and he agreed to come to the Fort Pierce Police Department to be interviewed. During the interview, Greg Evans was read Miranda and waived his right and continued talking to detectives. During the course of the interview, Greg Evans admitted to being at the house at the time of the robbery and observing the other two individuals he was with, shoot at the homeowner. He also stated that he knew that his friend Isaac "poochie" Collins had been shot during the encounter. Greg Evans was also able to positively identify the third suspect involved as Shannon Holloman. This identification was made by showing Evans a photo line-up/array. Evans positivley identified Holoman and initialled the photograph.
