Local popular pizza restaurant hit in brief crime spree Two men arrested

FORT PIERCE – Two Brevard County men were arrested in connection with an early morning crime spree that included stops at Big Apple Pizza, the City Marina and Indian River State College.

The suspects stole approximately \$5,000 in electronics which included three flat screen televisions, IPODS and cell phones. In addition, the suspects have been connected to two additional crimes that occurred at Wendy's and the tennis courts located near Virginia Avenue.

The suspects were arrested and transported to the St. Lucie County Jail without incident.

Narrative

On 3/17/09, at approximately 0300 hrs, Det Cuti and I responded to 100 Avenue A (City Marina parking lot) in reference to road patrol officers being in custody of two adult male burglary suspects.

Upon arrival I was informed that independent witness Jean Claudy (Security Guard for Command Security) observed a red Pontiac suspect vehicle (FL tag E86-2AF) travel Eastbound on the 100 block of Avenue A at approximately 0125 hrs. The suspect vehicle stopped in the parking area (located just South of the 100 block A Avenue) for approximately 1 minute. Mr Claudy then observed the suspect vehicle park directly next to a black Toyota pickup truck, victim's vehicle (FL tag C67-9KB)

A W/M suspect #1, wearing a multi colored hooded jacket and an unknown race male suspect #2 wearing a black shirt exited the suspect vehicle. Mr Claudy observed the suspects near the victim's vehicle for approximately 40 minutes. Mr Claudy then observed suspect 1 break/ smash the drivers side rear window of the victim vehicle (black Toyota) followed by suspect 1 entering the vehicle.

Ofc C.D. Davis responded to the scene and observed suspect 1 inside the victim vehicle and suspect 2 standing near the suspect vehicle.

In plain view inside the suspect vehicle were several items matching the description of items stolen in recent burglaries (3x flat screen T.V.s/ audio equipment)

Both suspect were taken in to custody and transported to 920 S US-1 (Detective Bureau) FPPD for questioning.

Suspect 1 was identified as Edward R Lewis and suspect 2 was identified as Robert S Friddle.

Lewis was read Miranda and signed a Miranda waiver. Post Miranda, Lewis stated that he and Friddle (suspect 2) traveled from Brevard County to Fort Pierce in Friddle's vehicle (suspect vehicle red Pontiac) in an attempt to getaway from the normal stress of their hometown.

NOTE: The following statements are chronological and provide details on three incidents where Friddle and Lewis were involved in criminal activity. The statements were heard during a taped interview between Edward Lewis, Det Cuti, and myself.

Lewis stated that he and Friddle traveled to 3209 Virginia Avenue (IRSC parking lot) where Friddle observed a gray Mitsubishi Eclipse (FL tag R80-7BB) parked in the lot. Lewis stated that Friddle said the following, "look at the radio in that sweet car." Friddle removed an extrication device (crow bar) from within his vehicle (red Pontiac) and broke/ smashed the drivers door window. Lewis then removed the radio from the vehicle. (SEE CASE # 2009-4-03363).

Lewis then stated that he and Friddle traveled to 2311 S 35th Street (Big Apple Pizza) where Friddle, once again, used an

device and pried the rear West door of the business. Lewis stated that both he and Friddle gained access to the business and removed three flat screen T.V.s and some Pepsi. Lewis stated that they then traveled to Wendy's (S US-1/ Virginia Avenue) where they "situated the car". (SEE CASE # 2009-4-03378).

Lewis stated that he and Friddle then traveled to the City Marina (100 Ave A) where they observed the black Toyota (C67-9KB). Lewis and Friddle wondered if there was a radio or money in the vehicle. Lewis stated the following, "We popped the window, I was gonna grab the CD player but I didn't, I took a "Blue Tooth" head set but it might be in the back of the cop car". Lewis stated that he did it for money to help pay his moms bills.

Robert Friddle was read Miranda and signed a Miranda waiver as well as a consent to search for his vehicle. Det Cuti and I then questioned Robert Friddle during a taped interview. Friddle stated that following: Lewis and I drove to Fort Pierce because it is a nice place, and I recently broke up with my ex-girlfriend so he needed to take a break. "I am not a thief, I am just a driver." "I am admitting to the pizzeria thing, I was not present when the door was being opened". When asked, Who opened the door? Friddle replied, " I don't know."

The interviews were recorded on CD and placed in to evidence.

Edward R Lewis and Robert S Friddle violated FS: 810.02 4 Burglary Of Conveyance Unarmed W/O Person Inside and FS: 812.014 3a Larceny Petit.

Search incident to arrest, Robert S Friddle was found in possession of a small amount of marijuana under 20 grams which violates FS: 893.13 6b.

Lewis and Friddle were transported to the St Lucie County Jail.

Narrative

On Tuesday 03/17/09 I, Officer Jaques responded to the Big Apple Restaurant located at 2311 S. 35th Street in reference to a burglary past.

Officer Woodruff had arrested two suspects for burglary to a vehicle. The two suspects had a car full of suspected stolen merchandise. Woodruff transported them to the detective bureau where they were interviewed by Detective Cuti. The suspects admitted to Detective Cuti that they had also burglarized Big Apple in addition to the motor vehicle.

The rear metal door to Big Apple had been pried open with some unknown tool. I entered the business and immediately noticed three empty spots on the walls where televisions had been. The brackets for the flat screens were still attached to the walls. The cash register was open and only had change inside of it sitting on the counter. I noticed behind the counter where papers were thrown about as if someone was looking for something in a hurry.

The owner of the business, Scott Van Duzer arrived on scene after being notified of the burglary to his business. Scott stated that he did not have any cameras or an alarm system for the business. I asked Scott what time the business closed and he stated 10:00 PM. Scott inventoried his business to see what was missing and stated that the cash register door is always left open in case of a burglary so that the register is not damaged. Scott stated the register always contains sixty five dollars in various increments. Scott said that the three televisions missing were all new flat screen televisions. Two of the missing televisions missing were 32 inch Sharp Aquos valued at \$949.00 each. The third television missing was a 50 inch Samsung valued at \$1699.00. The owner Scott also noticed some two liter Pepsi's missing but unknown how many.

CSI Greiner arrived to process the crime scene. Greiner took photographs of the scene and lifted footprints left on the table by the suspects. The missing items appear to be consistent with what was found in the suspects vehicle, see case# 2009-4-03373.

Nothing further to report, investigation turned over to the detective bureau.

Narrative

On 3/17/09, at approximately 0300 hrs, Det Cuti and I responded to 100 Avenue A (City Marina parking lot) in reference to road patrol officers being in custody of two adult male burglary suspects.

Upon arrival I was informed that independent witness Jean Claudy (Security Guard for Command Security) observed a red Pontiac suspect vehicle (FL tag E86-2AF) travel Eastbound on the 100 block of Avenue A at approximately 0125 hrs. The suspect vehicle stopped in the parking area (located just South of the 100 block A Avenue) for approximately 1 minute. Mr Claudy then observed the suspect vehicle park directly next to a black Toyota pickup truck, victim's vehicle (FL tag C67-9KB)

A W/M suspect #1, wearing a multi colored hooded jacket and an unknown race male suspect #2 wearing a black shirt exited the suspect vehicle. Mr Claudy observed the suspects near the victim's vehicle for approximately 40 minutes. Mr Claudy then observed suspect 1 break/ smash the drivers side rear window of the victim vehicle (black Toyota) followed by suspect 1 entering the vehicle.

Ofc C.D. Davis responded to the scene and observed suspect 1 inside the victim vehicle and suspect 2 standing near the suspect vehicle.

In plain view inside the suspect vehicle were several items matching the description of items stolen in recent burglaries (3x flat screen T.V.s/ audio equipment)

Both suspect were taken in to custody and transported to 920 S US-1 (Detective Bureau) FPPD for questioning.

Suspect 1 was identified as Edward R Lewis and suspect 2 was identified as Robert S Friddle.

Lewis was read Miranda and signed a Miranda waiver. Post Miranda, Lewis stated that he and Friddle (suspect 2) traveled from Brevard County to Fort Pierce in Friddle's vehicle (suspect vehicle red Pontiac) in an attempt to getaway from the normal stress of their hometown.

NOTE: The following statements are chronological and provide details on three incidents where Friddle and Lewis were involved in criminal activity. The statements were heard during a taped interview between Edward Lewis, Det Cuti, and myself.

Lewis stated that he and Friddle traveled to 3209 Virginia Avenue (IRSC parking lot) where Friddle observed a gray Mitsubishi Eclipse (FL tag R80-7BB) parked in the lot. Lewis stated that Friddle said the following, "look at the radio in that sweet car." Friddle removed an extrication device (crow bar) from within his vehicle (red Pontiac) and broke/ smashed the drivers door window. Lewis then removed the radio from the vehicle. (SEE CASE # 2009-4-03363).

Lewis then stated that he and Friddle traveled to 2311 S 35th Street (Big Apple Pizza) where Friddle, once again, used an

device and pried the rear West door of the business. Lewis stated that both he and Friddle gained access to the business and removed three flat screen T.V.s and some Pepsi. Lewis stated that they then traveled to Wendy's (S US-1/ Virginia Avenue) where they "situated the car". (SEE CASE # 2009-4-03378).

Lewis stated that he and Friddle then traveled to the City Marina (100 Ave A) where they observed the black Toyota (C67-9KB). Lewis and Friddle wondered if there was a radio or money in the vehicle. Lewis stated the following, "We popped the window, I was gonna grab the CD player but I didn't, I took a "Blue Tooth" head set but it might be in the back of the cop car". Lewis stated that he did it for money to help pay his moms bills.

Robert Friddle was read Miranda and signed a Miranda waiver as well as a consent to search for his vehicle. Det Cuti and I then questioned Robert Friddle during a taped interview. Friddle stated that following: Lewis and I drove to Fort Pierce because it is a nice place, and I recently broke up with my ex-girlfriend so he needed to take a break. "I am not a thief, I am just a driver." "I am admitting to the pizzeria thing, I was not present when the door was being opened". When asked, Who opened the door? Friddle replied, " I don't know."

The interviews were recorded on CD and placed in to evidence.

Edward R Lewis and Robert S Friddle violated FS: 810.02 4 Burglary Of Conveyance Unarmed W/O Person Inside and FS: 812.014 3a Larceny Petit.

Search incident to arrest, Robert S Friddle was found in possession of a small amount of marijuana under 20 grams which violates FS: 893.13 6b.

Lewis and Friddle were transported to the St Lucie County Jail.
