Police investigate shooting death of Fort Pierce Man

Narrative

On June 26, 2009 at approximately 10:35 p.m. hours the Fort Pierce Police Department responded along with St. Lucie County Fire Rescue to 1200 block of Ormond Avenue in reference to a shooting. On arrival officers found Herby Innocent, a 22- year-old male, in the middle of the street unconscious and not breathing. St. Lucie County Fire Rescue pronounced him dead at the scene.

Detectives are canvassing the neighborhood and following up leads to try and find out the identity of the suspect and what led to the shooting of Innocent. Since the beginning of 2009 there have been four homicides in the City of Fort Pierce.
