Narrative

On Friday March 13, 2009 at approximately 1:13 pm, Fort Pierce Police Officers responded to 610 Delaware Avenue (Oculina Bank) in reference to a bank robbery that had just occurred.

On arrival, we found that a black male walked into the bank, handed a note to the teller and demanded money. The suspect did not brandish a weapon. While in the bank, the suspect took an undisclosed amount of cash and fled from the bank in a northwest direction on foot. The suspect is described as a black male, approximately 5'10" and 170 lbs. He was wearing jeans, a light colored shirt and a baseball cap.
