FORT PIERCE – Police investigate early morning shooting that left one dead.

The deceased, Terry Dexter Cox, 46, of 1513 Avenue, was found in a field near his home at about 6:05 a.m. today by a student on their way to school. Cox, fully clothed, was lying face down in the dirt and had been shot.

Detectives are investigating the incident. There is no suspect information available.

This is the first homicide of 2010 for the City of Fort Pierce.
