Police investigate shooting of Fort Pierce man

FORT PIERCE – Police search for a suspect involved in an afternoon shooting, while the victim is treated for his injuries at local hospital.

Shortly before 1 p.m., police responded to the intersection of Avenue D and North 20th Street in reference to shooting activity.

Before officers arrived, the victim, Michael Wilson, 34, of Fort Pierce, was taken by a friend to Lawnwood Regional Medical Center and Heart Institute. Wilson is in serious, but stable condition.

Detectives and officers are canvassing the neighborhood for the suspect, who was last seen fleeing the area in a champagne-colored Cadillac travelling north on North 20th Street.
