Fort Pierce Police Arrest Two Men Accused of Stealing Air Conditioning Unit

On March 22, 2011 The Fort Pierce Police Department arrested Alan Camp (33) and Michael Delorme (33) after two United States Customs and Border Protection Agents saw the men loitering in the area of St. Lucie Court in Fort Pierce and carrying an air conditioning unit into the van they were driving.

After seeing the two men put an air conditioning unit into their van and drive away, the Customs agents conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Fort Pierce Police Sergeant Brian Macnaught was driving in the area and met with the Customs agents at their traffic stop. Knowing there is an increasing number of air conditioner thefts being reported, combined with the fact that Fort Pierce Police had recently learned of a vehicle matching the description of this van, Sergeant Macnaught detained Camp and Delorme to further investigate the situation; Fort Pierce Police found out that there was in fact an air conditioner unit missing from 1807 St. Lucie Court. The officers also noticed that other air conditioning units had their service lines cut, but were not missing.

The two subjects were arrested and charged with Burglary, Grand Theft and Loitering and Prowling. Alan Camp was also charged with Possession of Burglary Tools. Detectives are working today to search the vehicle, where there are at least three more air conditioning units inside.
