Fort Pierce Police Department Arrest Albert Smith, Two Other Men- All Three Facing Multiple Charges

On April 21, 2011 detectives from the Fort Pierce Police Department received a tip that Albert Smith was hiding from police in a home in the 900 block of North 23rd Street. Police officers responded to the address and found Smith hiding in a closet of the house. While arresting Smith, officers found twenty three (23) crack cocaine rocks in his sock.

Also arrested at the home was Majic Powell (3-11-1991) of 1708 Avenue L and Kadarius Powell (Juvenile) 6-12-1994 of 902 North 23rd Street. Majic Powell was arrested on a warrant for failure to appear-possession of a firearm or ammunition by a convicted felon. He was also found to have thirteen (13) crack cocaine rocks during the arrest. Kadarius Powell (juvenile) was arrested on one count of robbery with a firearm. All are currently being held at the St. Lucie County Jail.

Albert Smith's charges stem from a series of robberies that the Fort Pierce Police have been investigating since November, 2010. Kadarius Powell has also been implicated in the same series of robberies and was charged yesterday with an incident that is a part of the robbery series involving Albert Smith. Majic Powell's charges are not connected with the robbery pattern.
