Fort Pierce Police Department Releases Photograph of Man Wanted in Connection with Recent Robberies

The Fort Pierce Police Department has obtained a warrant for the arrest of Curry Ceasar Cook (03-02-1986) and now needs community assistance to locate him.

Cook is wanted in connection with the recent rash of robberies where Hispanic men have been approached by men purporting themselves to be immigration/law officers. Cook is wanted on charges of Falsely Impersonating a Law Enforcement Officer and Robbery.
