Fort Pierce Police Make Arrest in Homicide Discovered this Morning

Fort Pierce Police Detectives are investigating the death of a man found in a vehicle in the 1600 Block of Citrus Avenue at approximately 9:00 am on March 19, 2011. The investigation began when police responded to 1602 Citrus Avenue and found a man dead inside a vehicle in front of the residence.

The man, whose identity is being withheld (pending family notification) had suffered obvious trauma was found by officers after neighborhood residents called 911 to report an abandoned vehicle parked in the roadway. When Fort Pierce Police arrived, the officers discovered the man, dead in the rear seat of the car.

Investigation led detectives to 1602 Citrus Avenue where they found evidence to indicate that the crime had taken place in the driveway. Subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Gilberto Galvez (2-4-1969) of 1602 Citrus Avenue Fort Pierce, Florida.

Galvez is being held without bond.
