UPDATE

Fort Pierce Police Department Investigating Death of ~~Three~~ Suspect Murder/Suicide

On April 15, 2011 at approximately 7:00 pm offices from the Fort Pierce Police Department received a 911 call from a woman at 511 Quincy Avenue. The caller told police that there was a man with a gun.

On arrival, police found Robin Carrier (4-19-1962- 511 Quincy Avenue) and Stephanie Carrier (6-3-1988- 511 Quincy Avenue) dead in the kitchen of the home and Christopher Covington (2-9-1986- 511 Quincy Avenue) dead in the garage. A three year old child was found inside a bedroom, unharmed. Initial investigation has determined that Christopher Covington became enraged and shot both victims before going to the garage where he took his own life.

While motive for the crime is still under investigation, Fort Pierce Police officers had arrested Covington in January 2011 for aggravated battery on a pregnant female (2011-4-00321). The victim in that case was Stephanie Carrier. Police are continuing the investigation today.
