Man Wanted in Fort Pierce Murder Surrenders to Authorities in Palm Beach County

Background

On May 1, 2011 at approximately 2:50 am Fort Pierce Police responded to 1101 Avenue D (Wilson's Store) regarding a shooting that had just occurred. On arrival, police found Denard Parker (3-11-1976) of 2806 Avenue G Fort Pierce, Florida dead. Parker was outside of Wilson's Store when found by police.

Parker's homicide is the fifth (5th) homicide in Fort Pierce in 2011 and the second (2nd) at Wilson's.

New Information

On Wednesday May 4, 2011 at approximately 12:30 am Bruce Curry (05-24-1991) surrendered to authorities at the Palm Beach County Jail in Belle Glade, Florida. Curry was arrested and is now being held at the Palm Beach County Jail.

Fort Pierce Police are still investigating the murder and are asking anyone with information about the crime to please call Crime Stoppers at 1-800-273-TIPS (8477) or Detectives Sal Garcia (772-468-1805 extension 5248) or David Cuti (772-468-1805 extension 5285). Tipsters can remain anonymous and may be eligible for up to a \$1,000.00 reward for information.

While we are uncertain that Curry turned himself in as a result of the coverage, we are pleased that we can reach out to our local media and utilize this resource in helping us strive for our goal of Protecting the Community We Serve.
