Fort Pierce Police Department Bust Marijuana Grow House

On Tuesday January 26, 2011 detectives from the Fort Pierce Police Department received a tip through the Port St Lucie Police Department indicating a marijuana grow house was located at 1708 South 8th Street in Fort Pierce. Acting on that tip, detectives went to the house and contacted two residents. While on scene detectives noticed what they believed to be signs of a grow operation and obtained a search warrant for the residence.

With assistance of members of the Drug Enforcement Administration, Fort Pierce Detectives searched the house and found a fully operational, professionally built marijuana grow operation. Detectives seized fifty eight (58) mature marijuana plants, evidence of previously harvested marijuana plants and grow house equipment that includes high powered lighting, electrical ballast and temperature regulating materials. Fort Pierce Police arrested the two residents, who are facing multiple charges in connection with the operation. Arrested were:
